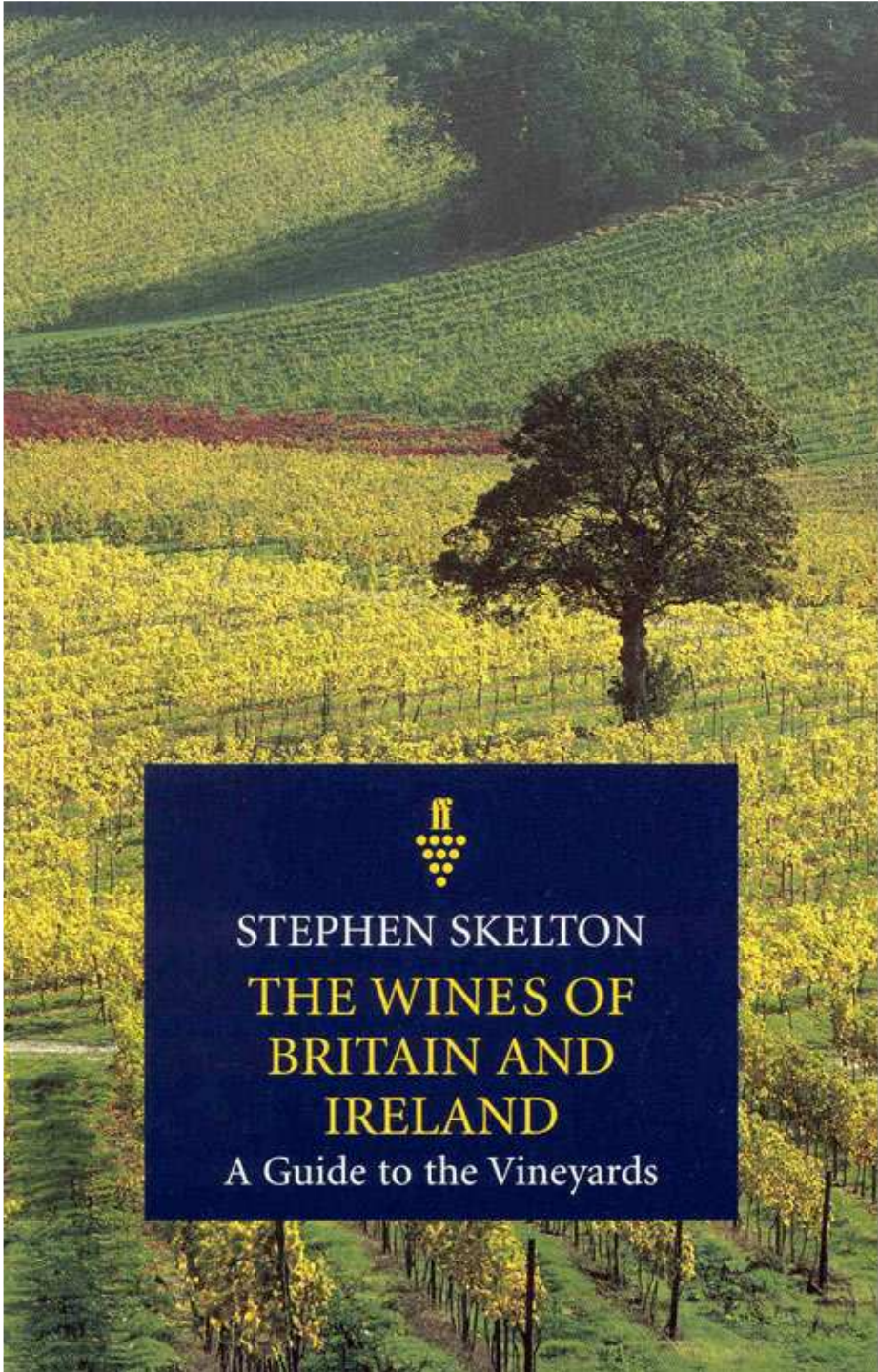

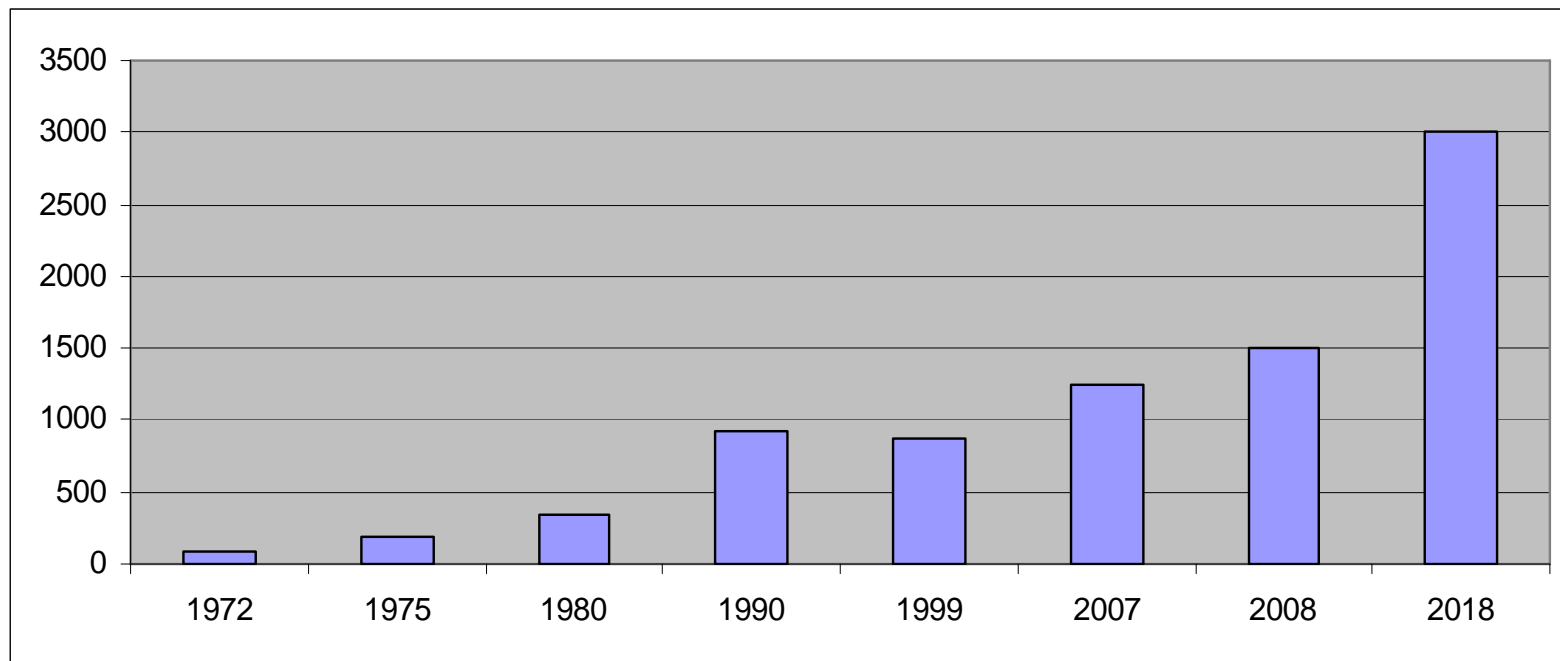

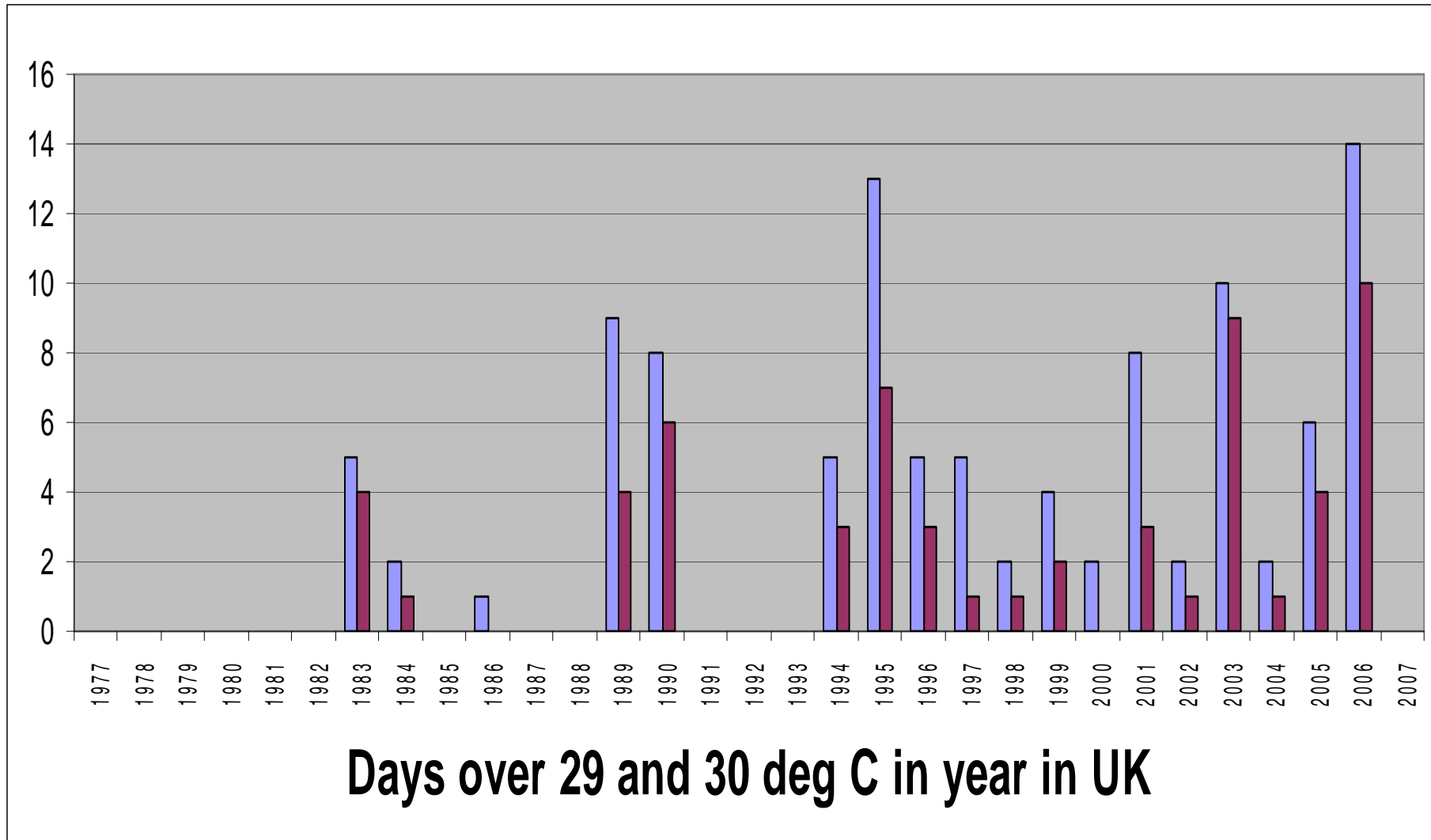

Viticulture in the UK

- Ability to grow classic varieties such as Chardonnay and Pinot noir for sparkling wine which have marketing advantages.
- Better yields. 50-75 hl/ha now achievable
- Higher sugar levels. 8-9% typical.
- Acidities for Chardonnay 10-15 g/l (as tartaric) are manageable.

Viticulture in the UK

- Pinot noir (Champagne clones)
- Chardonnay
- Bacchus
- Müller-Thurgau
- Seyval blanc
- Schönburger
- Meunier

Viticulture in the UK

- Yields are now more regular & 50-75 hl/ha achievable
- Land is not expensive €16,000-20,000 ha
- No vine planting ban
- Market of 20 m wine-drinkers within 150 km of main winegrowing regions
- Market for sparkling wines growing at 5% per annum
